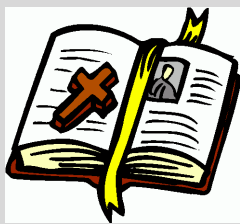

Summer Saint

St. Monica (331-387)

Born in present-day Algeria, St. Monica was married to Patricius, a Roman pagan. Patricius had an ugly temper and was unfaithful to Monica, but he respected her faith and devotion. She had two sons and one daughter, the most famous of whom is St. Augustine. When Augustine began leading a wayward life, Monica began praying unceasingly for his conversion. Her prayers were answered after 17 years, making her the patron saint of patience, and Augustine went on to become one of the greatest theologians of the Church. Her latter years were spent working with the poor and continued prayer. She died at Ostia, Italy. Augustine recorded his grief over her death in his famous "Confession."

In Her Memory:
