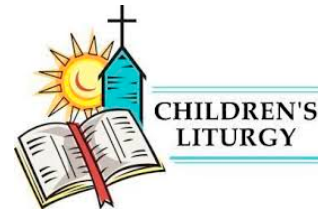
Generations in Reading

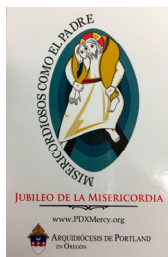
