## PARISH REGISTRATION

**Why is it so important that we register in a parish?  
Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?**

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. Membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled. Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

Not sure if you are registered or current? Contact the Parish Office to check your status or update your information. Please remind new parishioners, and your young adults, of the importance of registration and becoming an official member of our St. Mary parish.

### How to Register at St. Mary

Registering as a parishioner at St. Mary is easy. You can stop by the Parish Office to fill out a registration form, or you can download the registration form at <https://www.stmaryeugene.com/wp-content/uploads/2018/07/St-Mary-Parish-Registration-Form.pdf>. Please return the completed form to the Parish Office in person, by mail, or drop the registration in the Offertory basket at Mass.

## PLANT A MARY GARDEN THIS SPRING

A Mary garden is a small sacred garden enclosing a statue or shrine of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The practice originated among monasteries and convents in Medieval Europe. During the Middle Ages, people saw reminders of Mary in the flowers and herbs growing around them. Select flowers, shrubs, and trees associated with the legends about Mary are planted in the garden, all of which are identified as symbolic and significant in the story of Mary as recounted in the Bible. Locally available plants include Baby's Breath - *Our Lady's Veil*, Cornflower - *Our Lady's Crown*, Larkspur - *Mary's Tears*, Primrose - *Mary's Candlestick*, and Rose - *The Emblem of Mary*.

Creating a Mary Garden demonstrates devotion and commitment through the spiritual practice of designing, building, and maintaining the garden for the attendance, contemplation, and prayers of visitors.

## WHAT IS EUCHARISTIC ADORATION?

The practice of Eucharistic Adoration is a centuries old ritual and falls within a broader category of devotions and rituals that are associated with the Sacrament of the Eucharist. In a particular way, Eucharistic Adoration is an extension of the worship and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament that occurs in every Mass.

In a long-standing practice, a period of Eucharistic Adoration often ends with "benediction," the blessing of the faith with the Blessed Sacrament.

Several parishes throughout the United States have introduced the practice of perpetual Eucharistic Adoration, while other communities have the custom of shorter periods of Eucharistic Adoration. Care should always be taken that these periods of adoration respect the instructions outlined in Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharist Outside of Mass, the liturgical book that gives the instructions for the proper celebration of Eucharistic Adoration.

Although adoration of the Blessed Sacrament can never take the place of Eucharistic Communion, many Catholics find great comfort and consolation in their prayers before the Eucharist enshrined in the tabernacle or when it is exposed in the monstrance (both are equally valid, as the Christ is not more present in one than in the other). But when we consider our eucharistic devotions, it is always important to remember the fundamental connection these acts of devotion have in the celebration of the Eucharist in the Mass and reception of Christ in Communion.

## REGISTRO PARROQUIAL

**¿Por qué es tan importante que nos registremos en una parroquia? ¿No es suficiente que vayamos a Misa?**

El registro es la forma oficial en que nos unimos a una comunidad parroquial. Muchas personas piensan que porque asisten a una parroquia en particular, automáticamente pertenecen. A veces, los adultos jóvenes que se han mudado lejos durante años piensan que todavía están inscritos por sus padres. Pero la membresía requiere registrarse, inscribirse formalmente en una parroquia. El registro es un compromiso con una comunidad, una forma de ser incluido en las actividades religiosas, sociales y ministeriales de su parroquia. Su registro afecta a la parroquia de muchas maneras. Los números del censo pueden determinar cuántos sacerdotes se asignan a una iglesia, qué beneficios y obligaciones tiene la comunidad para con la diócesis y cómo se planifican y programan misas, confesiones y devociones. El registro muestra que perteneces. También es necesario para ciertos beneficios, como programar sacramentos, obtener certificados de patrocinador y obtener declaraciones de donación para impuestos. Lo que es más importante, permite que la parroquia cuente con usted, que lo llame para ayudar en su misión. Registrarse en su parroquia es una declaración de fe y confianza en la vida y obra de su parroquia.
