TRANSUBSTANTIATION & CONCOMITANCE

To be Catholic means that we believe in the Transubstantiation, a fundamental doctrine of our faith. It refers to the total and substantial change of bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ, which takes place at the moment of consecration in the Mass. When the priest says the Epiclesis—the intercessory prayer—he calls upon the Holy Spirit, and in uttering the Words of Institution, the bread and wine are substantially changed to the Body and Blood of Christ. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us "Christ himself, living and glorious, is present in a true, real, and substantial matter: his Body and his Blood, with his soul and his divinity" (CCC 1413).

In discussing the Transubstantiation, we must also understand the Doctrine of Concomitance. Concomitance means that under either form or "species"—bread or wine—the whole of Christ (Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity) is present. St. Thomas Aquinas offers this explanation: "nothing is lost by the Body being received by the people without the Blood." Christ cannot be divided; he is whole and present in the Eucharist whether we receive his Body or his Blood in Communion.

From the Catechism of the Catholic Church: 1419 Having passed from this world to the Father, Christ gives us in the Eucharist the pledge of glory with him. Participation in the Holy Sacrifice identifies us with his Heart, sustains our strength along the pilgrimage of this life, makes us long for eternal life, and unites us even now to the Church in heaven, the Blessed Virgin Mary, and all the saints.

DISTRESSING LEGISLATION IN OREGON

Oregon Right to Life would like you to know that there are three bills in Oregon of which Catholics should be aware.

- **House Bill 2002:** Removes age limits on minors receiving abortions, sterilizations or "gender-affirming" care and prohibits any information from being shared with a child's parents unless the child provides explicit, written permission.
- **House Bill 2279/Senate Bill 891:** Removes the Oregon residency requirement for physician-assisted suicide, endangering vulnerable people outside of Oregon.
