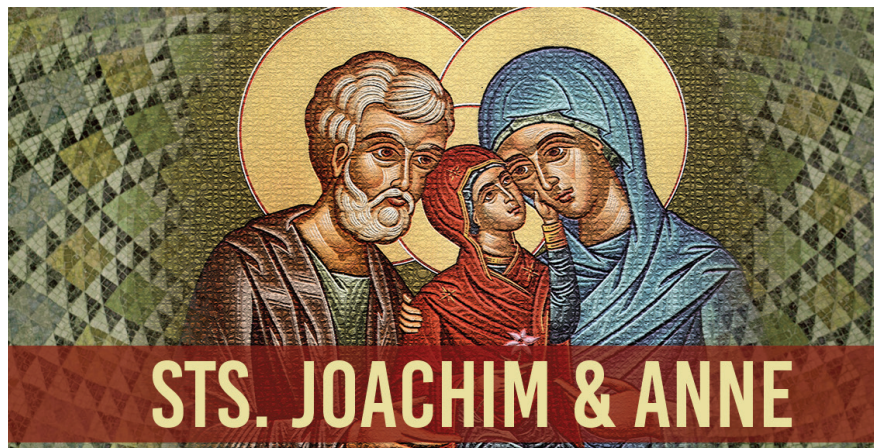

With the new Mass schedule, the Saturday Vigil Mass is now being said in English. However, there has been some confusion because it is being celebrated as a High Mass, with full ceremonial, including the use of incense. In a High Mass, it is traditional for the priest to face toward liturgical east, also known as ad orientem. So when attending a High Mass, the priest will face the back altar, incense will be used, and there will be more singing, including the Creed, which will be done in Latin because of the superior musical setting. 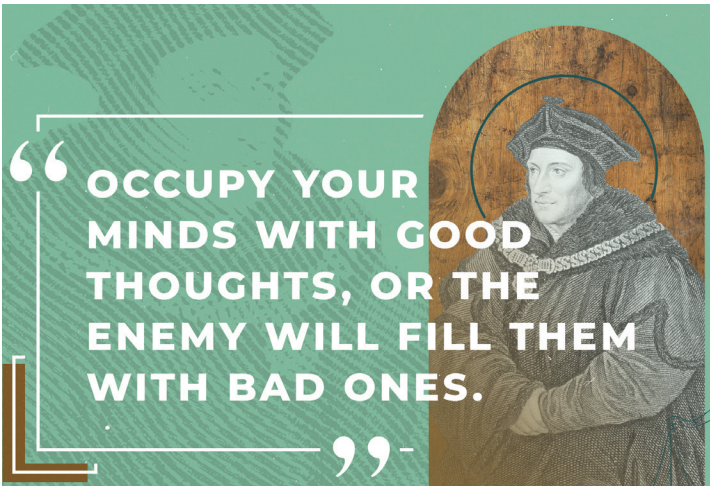

### WHAT TO DO WHEN A CHILD ASKS, "WHAT IS THE EUCHARIST?"

For preschoolers, explain the Eucharist in simpler terms. Say to these littlest, "Raise your hand if you have seen the priest hold up the big white Host - a big white circle at Mass." Let them all respond. Then, to be sure that everyone is visualizing the same moment at Mass, look at an actual picture (below) of a priest holding up the Eucharist at Mass.

Pointing to the Eucharist in the picture, say, "with the words of the priest and by the power of the Holy Spirit the big white Host becomes the Eucharist! That is Jesus!"

Jesus said, "This is my body." Since we know we can trust Jesus, we believe it!

The host may still look like round, flat bread, but is really Jesus . . . His Body, His Blood, His Soul, and His Divinity, His kingship and Godliness.

(The website, Guided Children's Adoration, has three visual lessons: Seeing the Body and Blood of Jesus with Faith, Jesus in His Sacramental Garment, and Our 5 Senses and His Word to teach children Jesus' True Presence in the Eucharist, "the source and summit" of our Catholic faith.)

Así es como dice la leyenda: encuentras una parroquia católica devota y una comunidad católica devota llena de católicos devotos que se preocupan por las cosas católicas devotas, y si te mantienes alejado de todo y de todos los demás, tú y tus hijos estarán a salvo de la influencia del maligno. Tus hijos nunca se apartarán de la fe, ni siquiera serán tentados, y tu propia fe se mantendrá firme en medio de las muchas tempestades y pruebas de esta vida terrenal.
