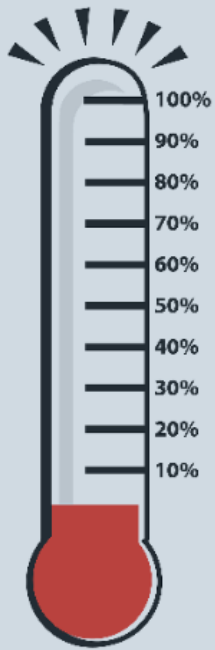

A MESSAGE FROM FR. RON



Dear Parishioners of St. Mary, I'd like to invite you to prayerfully consider donating for a large project. We will be working with Evergreen Roofing to replace the roof on the Parish center in September. The cost of the project will be about **\$138,737**. Over the years, we have tried many little patches to try to fix some water leaks, most notably in the Adoration chapel. None of these have worked, so we are going to take the step of replacing the roof completely in order to finally fix the leaks. We will be including in the bulletin each week a little thermometer to keep track of our progress to cover the costs of this project. Thank you!

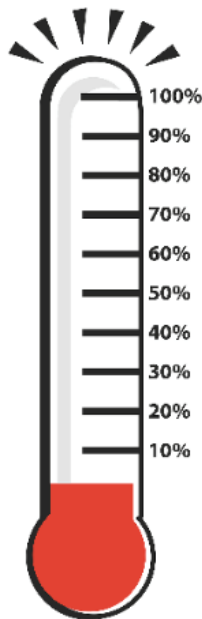
