At times, young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled.

On **Thursday, February 1**, from 6:00–7:30 pm O'Hara has the unique opportunity to welcome the Founder of Education in Virtue, Sister John Dominic and licensed clinical psychologist, Dr. Karen Villa to O'Hara Catholic School to discuss the integration of grace, virtue, and interpersonal neurobiology as Catholic social, emotional learning.

## CONFIRMATION CLASS FOR ADULTS

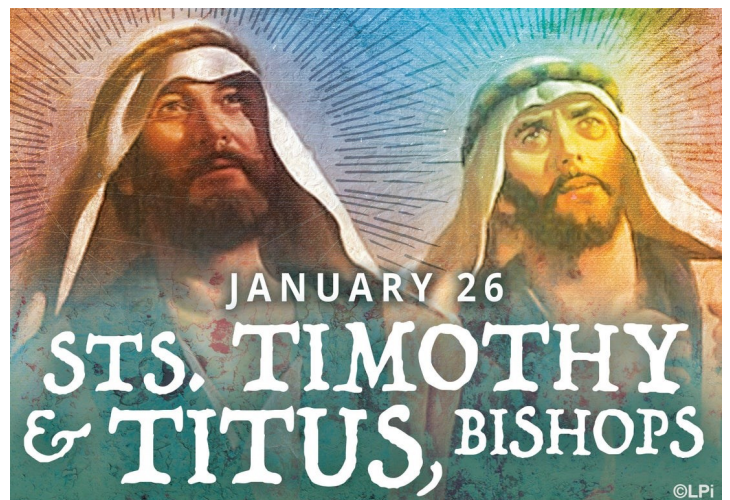
